

Tour Description

This is an opportunity to gain insight into the influences resulting from the influx of different cultures over the centuries and the different milestones, which have shaped our City and will continue to do so in the future.

Whilst we cover determining factors of our history, the focus however of this experience will be on modern and contemporary Cape Town and the city's developments. Cape Town is a cross-cultural melting pot and a city alive with positive and creative urban energy, and winner of the global Virgin Holidays Responsible Tourism Award in 2009.

To gain a richer understanding of our recent history and our quest to overcome the most drastic hurdles, the tour starts with a visit to the District Six Museum's powerful photo and memorabilia exhibition before we move on to current projects striving to maintain a balance between different socio-economic and ecological elements of this colourful cultural metropolis.

We start our walk through the city centre and take you behind-the-scenes to meet interesting Capetonians, to hear their stories and perspective of the City for yourself!

Time permitting our walk includes a stop to meander through the street kiosks of Green Market Square, a local market with a distinctive African flair. A visit to the Flower Market in historical Adderley Street is another opportunity to discover more of local culture. To conclude we'll walk up well-known and trendy Long Street populated with eclectic clothing stores, small galleries, bead merchants and retro cafes to end the experience with a cup of Fair Trade certified coffee or an indigenous Rooibos¹ latte at a local café.

Tour includes:

- Transfers CTICC to start and end of walking tour meeting points
- Guided walk with accredited guide (approximately 3.5 hours – depending on the interests and fitness of guests)
- Access to “behind-the-scenes” and discussions with formal and/or informal business individuals (e.g. local traders, art gallery owners, project leaders, vendors) and other interesting personalities of the Mother City.²
- Entrance fee District Six Museum³

Tour excludes:
